Media Coverage/Web Site Photo & Name Release Form Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulations

When images of students are shared with the public, either through school division publications, media coverage, or on web sites, all school division staff must be mindful of their obligations under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. If staff wishes to publicly share this kind of personal information about students, informed consent must be obtained from a person who is legally authorized to consent on the student's behalf (parent or guardian), and/or the student.

1. Media Coverage – Sporting Events

The media covers sporting events at our school. We require permission for the student named above to participate in media coverage at school (being photographed, video taped or interviewed). Media coverage typically includes the use of a student's name and school.

2. Photographs on the SSSAD Web Site

Action photographs of student athletes (where the students **cannot be visually identified**) may be posted on the SSSAD web site for an undetermined period of time during the current school year. Schools will be identified in these photographs. Parental/student permission is **not** required for these kinds of photographs. However, parental/student permission is required before photographs of individual students (**who can be visually identified**) are posted on the SSSAD web site. Students will **not** be identified by name and school in these photographs.
